The disaster

In December 2015, Winter Storm Goliath brought severe weather and tornadoes to a large part of the Plains, Midwest and Northeast. The unprecedented event caused by a dangerous combination of heavy rain, snow and river flooding set historic water level records across the state of Missouri. In St. Louis alone, the river crested at 42.58 feet – just shy of the record.

Because this disaster occurred the day before Christmas Eve, it received very little attention, despite the fact that 33 counties received a declaration for Individual Assistance and over 2,400 individuals and families applied for grants from FEMA.
